We are looking forward to a fantastic camp!

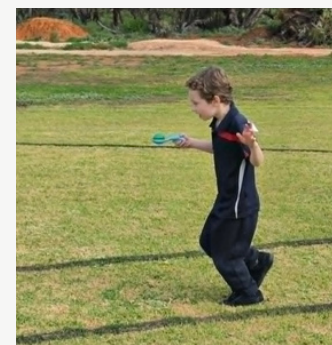
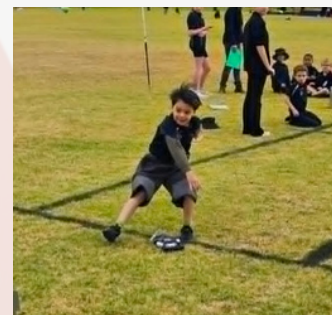

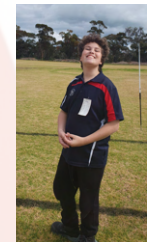
WHO: Students, families and our wider community
